Sunday, June 3rd – The Tudor Wardrobe

Join The Tudor Tailor for a lively look inside the clothes presses of ordinary and middle class people in 16th century England. Discover what evidence there is for their clothes, where their garments came from, and how they were made and maintained. This dressing demonstration compares and contrasts everyday wear with Sunday best and explains other clothing conventions of Tudor society. Ninya and Jane also discuss some of the challenges of recreating historic dress for 21st century wear. Reception and book signing following.

Practical workshop session for 20 people maximum. The Tudor Tailor demonstrates how to achieve perfectly fitted 16th century bodices and doublets. Methods employed are based on extensive research and experience of dressing people of all shapes and sizes for heritage sites around the U.K. Reconstructed garments are available for examination and each participant leaves the session with a paper pattern of their own individually fitted doublet or bodice. (**Please bring a yard of muslin (calico), scissors, pins and pencil.**)
